The Retraction is due to significant overlap and reusing text from sections of the author's own previously published work without proper citation, a breach of the publishing agreement and third party copyright concerns.

Our Joint Reasons and decision-making have been informed by our policy on [ethics](#) and [academic integrity](#) and the guidance of [COPE guidelines on retractions](#). In no way should this Retraction be interpreted as a punitive measure against the Author.

The Retracted Article will remain online to maintain the scholarly record, but it will be digitally watermarked on each page to indicate 'Retracted'.
